A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLYMPIA, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OLYMPIA AND THE INTERNATIONAL UNION OF OPERATING ENGINEERS LOCAL #612.

WHEREAS, City representatives engaged in collective bargaining with representatives from the International Union of Operating Engineers Local #612, which represents Public Works Department Operations Supervisors (Employees); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the collective bargaining was to negotiate an agreement for the purposes of establishing wages, hours and other conditions of employment for all full-time and regular part-time operations supervisors of the City of Olympia Public Works Department in general services, transportation, water resources and waste resources, excluding confidential employees and all other employees; and

WHEREAS, the negotiations resulted in a collectively bargained agreement (hereafter the "IUOE Agreement") that is beneficial to both parties and meets the financial objectives of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Olympia City Council hereby accepts the terms of the IUOE Agreement for the term of 2019 through 2021;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE OLYMPIA CITY COUNCIL DOES HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:

- 1. The Olympia City Council hereby accepts the terms and conditions negotiated with the International Union of Operating Engineers Local #612 for the term of 2019 through 2021.
- 2. The City Manager is directed and authorized to execute on behalf of the City of Olympia the Agreement between the City of Olympia and the International Union of Operating Engineers Local #612, and any other documents necessary to execute said Agreement, and to make any minor modifications as may be required and are consistent with the intent of the Agreement, or to correct any scrivener's errors.
