The following are our comments on the report titled: DRAFT *REPORT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019 City's compliance with funding levels set forth in the Interlocal Agreement between the OMPD Board and Olympia City Council.*

- 1. The report shows budgeted funds matching the required amounts. When budgets were adopted, the City and the MPD planned to be in compliance with the Interlocal Agreement.
- 2. A complete history would be helpful to show year-to year budgets, revenues, and expenses. This should also include specifics on any funds that were transferred back to the general fund at year end.
- 3. Since capital budget projects often take several years to complete, the history should include details tracking the funds over time for these multi-years projects.
- 4. Any changes resulting from the audit may modify our comments on the report.

Separate from the report, we have appreciated the follow up from staff that has shown actual revenues and expenses. We value the open communications we have experienced with City and MPD staff.
