Project (Detailed Design Review): Recommended conditional approval as follows:

- Modification to the textured concrete patterns within the woonerf shall be made to incorporate any
  pavement markings required by the City's Building Official related to accessible routes and
  pedestrian safety pursuant to OMC 18.110.030 Connections, 18.110.050 Pedestrian amenities, and
  18.120.110 Pedestrian access from parking areas.
- Modify the textured concrete patterns to include a solid line extending across the woonerf to more clearly define the start of the queuing for the automated parking pursuant to OMC OMC 18.110.030 – Connections.
- 3. Add a sign in the woonerf indicating the start of the queuing line for the automated parking pursuant to OMC 18.120.110 Pedestrian access from parking areas and OMC 18.110.030 Connections.

4. Should fencing of the outdoor seating area be proposed in the future with the tenant occupation of the restaurant/bar, staff should review the fencing and ensure it maintains a human scale by providing openings at frequent intervals and that the fencing material is compatible with the structure pursuant to OMC 18.110.040.
