Ms.Johnson noted that the restrictions on gatherings due to COVID-19 have had a tremendous effect on the performing arts. She reminded Commissioners that most of the Grants to Arts & Culture Organizations (GACO)for 2020 had gone to performance-based projects. She noted that ArtsWA has allowed their grant recipients to direct their funding toward operations, should their project need to be canceled. Commissioners agreed to have Ms. Johnson determine if the same consideration could be made in the case of Olympia's GACO.
