6.A <u>21-0598</u> Budget Snapshot - 2021 Lodging Tax & Washington Center for Performing Arts

City Manager Jay Burney honored Finance Director Nanci Lien as she retires on July 1, 2021.

Ms. Lien presented the briefing. She explained what Lodging Tax is and how the City uses it. She reviewed the financial history of using Lodging Tax revenue to help support the Washington Center for Performing Arts.

6.B <u>21-0580</u> Washington Center for the Performing Arts Financial Position and Reopening and Recovery Plan

Economic Development Director Mike Reid and The Washington Center for Performing Arts (Center) Executive Director Jill Barnes shared the Center's financial position, operating budget, capital budget and COVID reopening and recovery plan. Ms. Barnes noted the Center ended its 2020 fiscal reporting year in the red but it wasn't as bad as expected.
