The Committee did not make a formal recommendation, but the general consensus was that if the City is to continue allowing memorial recognition, it should be in the form of a very small plaque or a name etched into the bench itself. Plaques on the ground should be avoided as this makes for a more "cemetery-like" atmosphere.
