Background and Analysis:

Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender and Queer+ (LGBTQ+) Pride Month is celebrated each year in the month of June to honor the 1969 Stonewall Uprising in Manhattan.

Olympia has a long history of celebrating and supporting the diversity of all its community members and visitors. 31 years ago, Capital City Pride organized the first small town Pride outside of Seattle and has continued its annual celebration since.

The City, its employees, elected officials, community members, places of business and visitors have always enthusiastically participated in Pride festivities every year but due to the COVID-19 pandemic
