Background and Analysis:

The City has several special accounts and funds which are not part of the Operating or Capital Budgets. These funds have been established for administrative purposes and/or to segregate funds for special purposes.

The ordinance reflects that \$1,500 has been added to the Lodging Tax Committee recommendations for Procession of the Species.

Neighborhood/Community Interests (if known):

Several members from the community testified in favor of Earthbound Productions receiving the additional funds at the Operating Budget Public Hearing.

Options:

- 1. Pass the ordinance on first reading and move to second reading as presented. The ordinance provides authority to expend funds for various purposes according to state law.
- 2. Pass the ordinance on first reading with different amounts and move to second reading. The ordinance would be changed as directed by Council for presentation on second reading.
