**Background and Analysis:**

The City has been in the process of updating its Comprehensive Plan since 2009, including an extensive public involvement program called *Imagine Olympia*. The Planning Commission held public hearings on the draft update on July 23 and 25, 2012; and public hearings with initial deliberations on September 17; October 1, 8, 15 and 29, 2012.

Final Deliberations will occur at regular meetings during January, February and March of 2013. The public record is closed at this time.
