Background and Analysis:

The City has been in the process of updating its Comprehensive Plan since 2009, including an extensive public involvement program called *Imagine Olympia*. The Planning Commission held public hearings on the draft update on July 23 and 25, 2012; and public hearings with initial deliberations on September 17; October 1, 8, 15 and 29, 2012.

Final Deliberations will occur at regular meetings during January, February and March of 2013. The Commission is no longer accepting oral testimony at this time.
