The Washington Center Operating Finances

**Issue:**

Consider a request from The Washington Center to use \$200,000 from the Center's Endowment to support and strengthen Center operations for the 2013-2014 program year.

**Background and Analysis:**

The City owns The Washington Center. It is operated by contract through a nonprofit organization directed by a volunteer Board of Directors. The economic recession has created budget challenges for the Center and lead the Board to embark on a revised business model for the Center. The Board has also recently hired a new Executive Director who will focus in large part on restoring fiscal balance in Center operations.

The Finance discussed this request at its August 22 meeting and generally committed to support the request. The Committee asked the Center to provide more specificity about how the money would be spent, a copy of the proposed budget for 2013-2014, a history of the Endowment drawdowns, and a plan to begin in restoring the Endowment. The Center has provided some of that information in the attached materials and will discuss these issues more thoroughly at the Finance Committee.

This is scheduled for action under the Consent Calendar on this evening's Council agenda.

**Neighborhood/Community Interests:**

The Washington Center provides a venue for dozens of local performing arts organizations. Ensuring success of the Center will allow these groups to continue and to thrive.

**Options:**

1. Recommend use of \$200,000 from the Endowment

**Financial Impact:**

The Washington Center Endowment has a current balance of approximately \$1.5 million.
