Background and Analysis:

This year, combined funding for WSDOT's Safe Routes to School and Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety programs is \$8 million statewide. The City leverages existing funding as matches for grants, in order to be more competitive.

Several projects recommended by staff for grant funding have been requested by the public.

Options:

Financial Impact:
