On September 29, the City Council met in a Special Work Session to discuss actions to take related moving forward in reimagining public safety in Olympia.

During the Special Work Session, next steps and desired outcomes related to public safety were identified. The next steps included the development of an Ad Hoc Public Safety Committee comprised of Mayor Selby, Councilmember Cooper and Councilmember Gilman.
