Background and Analysis:

The new Ad Hoc Public Safety Committee is proposing to meet monthly starting in January 2021 through August 2021 to correspond with the Re-Imagining Public Safety public engagement process.

Staff will present a draft work plan and schedule for their consideration. The work plan will be based on the Committee's stated purpose "...to develop a greater understanding of the current public safety system (policing, courts, jail, etc.) and consider recommendations to Council on policy and budget options that will reduce inequities, eliminate bias, and create a public system that works for all."
