Every six years, Olympia Parks, Arts and Recreation Department updates the Parks, Arts and Recreation Plan. The Plan includes the following nine chapters:

- Chapter 4: Community Involvement
- Chapter 5: Park and Facility Needs Assessment
- Chapter 6: Proposed Projects
- Chapter 7: Capital Facilities Plan
- Chapter 8: Goals and Policies
- Chapter 9: Performance Measures

Staff will review the contents of the Plan, including the priorities and capital projects proposed for the next six years.
