#### **Background and Analysis:**

The preliminary 2018 Olympia Metropolitan Park District (OMPD) budget was presented to the OMPD Advisory Committee on November 2, 2017. The presentation contained two options:

- a budget of \$3,615,342 that included \$100,000 for ADA upgrades and would result in an estimated 2018 levy rate of \$.54/1000 assessed value, and
- a budget of \$3,715,342 that included \$200,000 for ADA upgrades and would result in an estimated 2018 levy rate of \$.555/1000 assessed value

The OMPD Advisory Committee is recommending the \$3,615,342 budget option which would result in an estimated 2018 levy rate of \$.54/1000 assessed value. The hearing provides an opportunity for the OMPD Board to hear from the public on the budget of the Olympia Metropolitan Park District.
