A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLYMPIA, WASHINGTON, APPROVING A FUNDING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OLYMPIA AND CATHOLIC COMMUNITY SERVICES OF WESTERN WASHINGTON FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT, OPERATION, MANAGEMENT, AND MAINTENANCE OF A TINY HOUSE/SHELTER VILLAGE AT 1215 QUINCE STREET SE

WHEREAS, the City of Olympia declared a public health emergency related to homelessness on July 17, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the City has worked since then to find solutions that will assist in alleviating the homeless crisis in Olympia; and

WHEREAS, Catholic Community Services of Western Washington (CCS) has experience assisting persons who are homeless by managing and operating the City's former downtown tiny house/shelter facility and managing and operating a tiny house village at 1215 Quince Street SE, known as Quince Street Village. CCS is experienced in providing this type of transitional housing and providing homeless persons with essential services including hygiene, trash collection, utilities, and security to allow for the best chance for success in transitioning to permanent housing; and

WHEREAS, the City and CCS have negotiated terms and conditions whereby the City provides funding to CCS to enable CCS to establish, operate, manage, and maintain the Quince Street Village for the purpose of providing temporary shelter for homeless persons in tiny houses/shelters; and

WHEREAS, the City and CCS are entering into a separate Lease Agreement which governs CCS's lease of the Quince Street Village property for purposes of carrying out the operation, management, and maintenance of the tiny house/shelter facility as provided in the Funding Agreement.

WHEREAS, the City Council determines it to be in the best interest of the residents of the City of Olympia to provide funding to CCS to establish, operate, manage, and maintain a tiny house/shelter village in Olympia;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE OLYMPIA CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES as follows:

1. The Olympia City Council hereby approves the form of Funding Agreement between the City and Catholic Community Services of Western Washington to provide funding to Catholic Community Services for the establishment, operation, management, and maintenance of a tiny house/shelter village in Olympia upon the terms and conditions contained therein.
2. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute on behalf of the City of Olympia the Funding Agreement, and any other documents necessary to execute that

Agreement, and to make any minor amendments or modifications as may be required and are consistent with the intent of the Agreement, and to correct any scrivener's errors.
